

On June 29, the **General Statistics Office (GSO) of Vietnam** published <u>official GDP</u> <u>figures for Q2 2022</u>, reporting that the economy expanded by 7.72 percent, its highest rate in a decade and that the consumer price index (CPI) rose by just 2.96 percent.





EuroCham Conducted an FDI tour to DEEP C IZ and High-Level Meetings with Hai Phong and Quang Ninh Authorities







A EuroCham delegation led by Chairman Alain Cany toured Hai Phong and Quang Ninh last Friday, 26 August 2022. The delegation included an impressive number of fifty-plus attendees. The trip consisted of extensive high-level dialogues with the Hai Phong and Quang Ninh People's Committees and a visit to the iconic example of European investment success, DEEP C Industrial Zones. Many large European FDI companies attended, such as representatives from Air Liquide, Bosch, EDF Renewables, among others.

This trip provided highly productive and valuable opportunities for members to speak directly with government officials tasked with drawing European investment to their respective localities.

General Director of Deep C Bruno Jaspaert welcomed the delegation and provided an overview of the reasons for choosing the north as an investment location. In Hai Phong and Quang Ninh, DEEP C has developed five zones and leased 3,400ha of land, becoming the largest industrial zone developer in Vietnam and the leading eco-industrial park in the country. Delegation members were also introduced to the company's newly launched Deep C Farm project and given the opportunity to take a tour of its vast facilities.

Afterwards, the delegation met with the Hai Phong City People's Committee, including its Chairman Nguyen Van Tung, Vice-Chairman Hoang Minh Cuong and other agency representatives from Hai Phong's Economic Zone Authority (HEZA), Department of Industry and Trade (DOIT), Department of Planning and Investment (DPI), and Department of Foreign Affairs (DOFA).

Chairman Tung welcomed EuroCham's delegation and highlighted Hai Phong's rapid progress toward becoming a premier business location.

Vice Chairman Cuong opened a discussion on opportunities and incentives for European investors. A variety of questions from the delegation were then answered by Hai Phong's representatives.

Digital transformation and sustainable development are major focuses of Hai Phong, which provides **ample opportunities for European investment**, especially in the **power** and **IT sectors**.

Chairman Alain Cany expressed his gratitude for the warm reception. Also, he praised DEEP C as a European investor ambassador that has enhanced trade and sustainable development in Vietnam. He added that EuroCham will engage closely with Hai Phong agencies to promote quality European investment.

A meeting followed with representatives of **Quang Ninh's People's Committee** and various departments and agencies from the province.

Quang Ninh Economic Zone Authority Director Hoang Trung Kien presented an informative and comprehensive introduction, stating that Quang Ninh is a growth pole of the north. Foreign consultants are helping the province maximise its potential. With its continuous efforts in digital transformation and attractive incentives, Quang Ninh has retained its top position in the Provincial Competitiveness Index (PCI).

Furthermore, Mr. Kien shared information about the **Quang Ninh Investment Promotion Agency**, whose members are leaders of all departments of the People's Committee.

The agency and the People's Committee are calling for investments in **infrastructure**, **logistics**, and **energy (onshore and offshore wind)**.

Chairman Alain Cany expressed his deepest appreciation to the Quang Ninh People's Committee. He stressed that EVFTA will continue to increase high-quality European investments in the province.





<u>EuroCham Hosted a Breakfast Briefing on 2022 Tax Updates and their</u> <u>Impacts on Businesses in Vietnam</u>



On the morning of 24 August 2022, EuroCham Vietnam and RSM Vietnam welcomed more than thirty participants to our morning event titled "Tax Updates 2022 and Their Impacts on Businesses in Vietnam". As taxes have a direct impact on an organisation's ability to invest in operations, staff, and competition, participants were provided with information about **tax legislation**, **tax planning**, and **tax environment updates**.

[CNA] Vietnam 2022 exports to rise 9.46% to \$368 billion - ministry

23 August 2022 - "Vietnam's exports are forecast to rise 9.46 per cent this year to \$368 billion, the trade ministry said, with the manufacturing hub expected to benefit from newly-signed



trade deals despite economic headwinds in its major markets."

"The Southeast Asian country has signed more than a dozen free trade agreements in recent years, including one with the European Union and an 11-country CPTPP deal that will slash tariffs across much of the Asia-Pacific."

[Vietnam Net] Vietnam is the fifth most open economy in Asia



25 August 2022 - "Vietnam ranks as the fifth most open economy in Asia out of 37 nations evaluated by Fitch Solutions in its Vietnam Trade & Investment Risk Report."

"The Vietnamese economy was assigned a score of 74.6 out of 100, surpassing both the Asian and world averages of 49.5 and 46, respectively. Vietnam also gets a higher rating than Singapore, Hong Kong, Macao, and Malaysia. Globally, Vietnam is ranked 20th out of 201 markets evaluated by this organisation."

[Vietnam Plus] Vietnam attracts nearly 16.8 bln USD in FDI in eight months

26 August 2022 - "Vietnam raked in nearly 16.8 billion USD in foreign direct investment (FDI) as of August 20, down 12.3% year-on-year, according to the Foreign Investment Agency (FIA) under the Ministry of Planning and Investment."

"In the period, a remarkable decrease was seen in the value of newly-registered capital, down 43.9% to 6.35 billion USD. Meanwhile, additional



capital injected into existing projects rose by 50.7% to 7.5 billion USD; and capital contributions and share purchases was up 3.6% to 2.9 billion USD."


[Vietnam Express] Vietnam to get 22 million tourists in 2026: Fitch



27 August 2022 - "Vietnam is expected to receive 22 million foreign visitors in 2026 and see tourism revenues grow by 25 percent from pre-pandemic levelsto US\$13.2 billion, Fitch Solutions forecast."

"In 2019 it had received a record 18 million foreign tourists. Its target for this year is five million."

27 August 2022 - "Vietnam's logistics industry is expected to thrive this year despite the global economic volatility, but sustainable long-term growth needs infrastructure development, analysts said."

"Freight volumes would increase in all transport subsectors as the country's economy recovers ... but Vietnam only ranks 71st out of 201 markets in terms of transport network ... with the limited extent and quality of network infrastructure being [key challenges for investors]."
